

BADGER PERSONAL ASSOCIATE – APPLICATION PROCESS

This document explains the application process for doctors seeking work with BADGER. In the first instance doctors should provide the following documentation:

- ◆ CV
- ◆ Current GMC registration certificate
- ◆ Current medical indemnity certificate (e.g. MDU, MPS, MDDUS)
- ◆ JCPTGP or PMETB certificate
- ◆ Evidence of inclusion on a performers list in England
- ◆ Evidence of British Citizenship or other nationality
- ◆ Evidence that you are entitled to work in the UK if not a British citizen
- ◆ The names of 2 recent referees (within the last three months).
- ◆ Details of work experience or training in out of hours.

When your documents have been received and checked you will be invited to attend an induction session involving:

- ◆ An overview of the BADGER organisation, its policies and procedures
- ◆ An introduction and skills assessment on the Aadastra computer system

After this your application will be considered by the Medical Director.

Once approved you will be sent a Personal Associate membership form.

When your Personal associate form is received back in BADGER a familiarisation session may be arranged with an experienced working doctor. A user ID and password for Aadastra and Rotamaster (our rota scheduling system) will be set up and you will be able to book sessions via our on-line system.

One or more steps may be skipped from this process depending on your level of experience and whether your OOH GP Vocational Training was with the Badger group.
